„Integrated assistance and services for asylum seekers in Romania - ASIST RO”

The general objective of the project

The overall objective of the project is to improve the living conditions of asylum seekers in Romania, by providing information on their rights and obligations under the law, providing social assistance and additional material services, as well as other specialized services.

By this Project, you are offered the following services:

- Information on the counseling, assistance and complementary facilities granted, regarding the assembly of social-economical rights and legal obligations you have as an asylum seeker (other than those related to the asylum procedure);
- Support in accessing the available public services, regarding: the labor market, the education system, the social insurance system, obtaining a home and cultural orientation;
- Effective material assistance, in order to improve your standard of living in Romania;
- Orientation and accommodation activities within the Romanian society (Romanian language lessons for children and adults, recreational-cultural activities, development of professional skills in order to adapt to the characteristics of the Romanian society, rules of coexistence within the centers, as well as in society, etc.).

Are You an Asylum Seeker in Romania?

You have the following social rights and obligations:

1. Rights:

- a) You can participate in cultural adaptation activities;
- b) If you do not have the necessary means of living, you can benefit, upon request, of the necessary assistance (such as food, care and hygiene materials, clothing and footwear, transport), during the asylum procedure;
- c) If you do not have the necessary means of living, you can be accommodated in a center for procedures and accommodation for asylum seekers;
- d) If you are a person with disabilities (with special needs) you can benefit from accommodation and assistance adapted to your situation;
- e) If you suffer from acute or chronic diseases that put your life in imminent danger, you can receive free primary and hospital emergency care, as well as free treatment, through the national system of qualified emergency and first aid assistance;
- f) You can be included in the national public health programs aimed for the prevention, surveillance and control of infectious diseases;
- g) If you are a person with disabilities (with special needs) you can receive adequate medical care;
- h) You can receive social assistance according to the legislation in force;
- i) You can gain access to the labor market if the asylum procedure is carried out in a court or if 3 months have passed from the date you applied for the asylum procedure and the IGI has not issued a decision in this regard, and this delay is not your fault. In this situation, you can benefit from measures which stimulate employment, as well as protection within the unemployment insurance system, under the conditions provided by law for Romanian citizens.
- j) If you are a minor, you are benefitting from the same protection offered, under the law, to Romanian minors in difficulty;
- k) If you are a minor, you will receive a free intensive training course for enrollment in the national education system. At the end of the course, an evaluation commission assesses your level of knowledge, including knowledge of the Romanian language and establishes your enrollment in the corresponding study year.

Access to social rights and material conditions of acceptance:

- a. You have the right to benefit from social assistance measures, upon request.
- b. You can receive, on request, food within the amount of 10 lei/ person/ day, clothing within the amount of 67 lei/ person/ in summer season and 100 lei/ person/ in winter season and other expenses, in limit of the amount of 6 lei/ person/ day, representing expenses with local transport, cultural services, press, repair and maintenance services, expenses with personal hygiene products.
- c. When the capacity of accommodation in the centers for procedures and accommodation for asylum seekers is exceeded, the General Inspectorate for Immigration, within the limits of the available funds, can grant you an amount of money for the purpose of renting a living space.
- d. **If you do not comply with the Internal Order Regulations of the IGI Regional Centers for Procedures and Accommodation, or if you do not respect the legal obligations you have, the General Inspectorate for Immigration may limit or withdraw your material conditions of acceptance.**

2. Obligations:

- a) **You have the obligation to comply with the laws of the Romanian state, as well as the measures taken by the Romanian bodies competent in the asylum field;**
- b) You have the obligation to submit to the territorial bodies of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, in writing, **the request for motivated asylum**, containing the data indicated by the body to which you submit it, as well as to accept to be photographed and fingerprinted. *If you are under the age of 14, the fingerprinting procedure is not done;*
- c) You have the obligation to present to the competent authorities **complete and real information** regarding your person and the asylum application;
- d) **You have the obligation to submit all the documents that you have available** and which are relevant to your personal situation;
- e) **You have the obligation to hand over the document for the crossing the state border**, to receive the temporary document for the asylum seeker (issued by the IGI);
- f) You have the obligation to follow the status of the procedure and to inform the General Inspectorate for Immigration about any change of residence;
- g) You have the obligation to respond to the requests of the bodies with attributions in the field of asylum;
- h) You have the obligation to attend the medical examinations that are set for you, as well as to undergo the vaccination;

- i) You have the obligation, at the request of the competent authorities, to undergo the corporal control and to show the objects that you have on you.
- j) You have the obligation to leave the territory of Romania within 15 days from the completion of the asylum procedure, if you did not obtain a form of international protection, unless the asylum application was rejected as obviously unfounded with a decision in an accelerated procedure, in which case you must leave the territory of the Romanian state as soon as the asylum procedure has been completed.

According to the **Internal Order Regulations of the Regional Centers for Procedures and Accommodation for asylum seekers**, for disciplinary violations, gradually and in proportion to the seriousness of the act, **you can be sanctioned** with:

Suspension of granting the amount of 6 lei / person / day, representing expenses with local transport, cultural services, press, repair and maintenance services, expenses for personal hygiene products for a period from one month to 3 months!

Temporary evacuation from the center for 24 hours!
Temporary evacuation from the center for 7 days!

DEFINITIVE evacuation from the center!
